<u>When your Child is Sick</u> – In anticipation of cold and flu season, we'd like to remind parents to be prudent when it comes to deciding when to keep your child home, or when to send him/her to school if he/she has just recovered from being ill. <u>Some basic guidelines are as follows</u>: **24 hours** after temperature returns to normal, or after gastrointestinal illness (vomiting/diarrhea); contagious infections such as suspected **pink eye or strep throat**; unexplained **skin rash; severe cough and cold** symptoms.
