Dear Families of St. Paul School,

It has been a most successful and productive year with our children making much progress! St. Paul Staff and Education Committee wish you all a restful and happy summer holiday. Following is some important information you will need to begin the 2017-2018 school year.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Please pay strict attention to the following paragraph about uniforms.

It is very important that every item that you send with your child is clearly labeled with their name.

This will help everyone keep track of clothing etc. Please include lunch kits, sweaters, shoes, shirts, and all small items such as pencils, felt pens, etc. Commercially purchased labels and permanent pens for labeling clothing are recommended as common pen markings regularly fade.

SCHEDULE FOR NEXT YEAR

The school day will begin at 8:45 a.m. and end at 3:00 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Wednesday is a weekly early dismissal staff meeting day. **The children will be dismissed at 2:00 p.m. each Wednesday.** This schedule allows an afternoon for you to arrange doctors' and dentists' appointments, piano lessons, etc. and allows teachers much needed planning/meeting time.

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 5th, 2017 - School Hours (8:45am - 12:00 noon)

School will open on Tuesday at 8:45a.m. All children should arrive at school in full uniform on this day. When the children go to their classrooms, the parents are invited to the gym for coffee and to meet one another and catch up after the summer. School will be dismissed at 12:00 noon on this day.

OPENING SCHOOL MASS WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 6th, 2017

 Our opening liturgy is scheduled for 11:00 a.m. and will be a special welcome to all new children and families. Scheduling Mass on this day will give the children time to settle in their new classes and will give teachers time to introduce the spiritual theme for this year:

"Care For Everyone In Our Common Home"

LOCKERS AND BACKPACKS

All students in Grade 1 to 7 have a personal locker for their belongings. It is very important to realize that these Lockers are not able to accommodate suitcases with wheels that act as backpacks. The lockers are hinged but will not survive the force that is constantly used to try to close a very over-filled space. The lockers need to hold a reasonably sized backpack, a lunch container, a jacket or coat and a pair of runners. Please see that your child's/children's "BOOK BAG" meets these essential requirements. If your child is not able to carry his/her own belongings then there are too many things in his/her bag.
