GUIDELINES FOR SELLERS & BUYERS

- 1. Please print out the attached tag and fill in the information requested. No need to fill out the Family Account number.
- 2. If you are unsure what price to sell your item for, you may leave it blank and fill it in at the Swap Meet when you get an idea of what the pricing of similar items is like.
- 3. Only uniforms with the correct and current design will be accepted. For example, golf shirts and sweaters/cardigans must have the St. Paul School name and crest on the left chest. PE shirts must have the school name on the left chest only. PE shorts must have the school name on the left shorts leg only. Any older versions of the school uniform will not be accepted. **Only proper uniform shoes will be accepted.**
- 4. Please ensure items are clean and in good condition, ie. colour is not faded, fabric is free of stains and tears, buttons are complete, shoes are in decent condition.
- 5. If you have uniform items that you wish to give away for free, you are welcome to bring them in. There will be a section for **Free Uniforms.**
- 6. If not all of your items are available that day, you may bring in one sample and try to find a buyer for them. It will be up to you to arrange

with your buyer as to when you will do the actual exchange of goods and payment. The delivered item(s) should be in the same condition as the sample presented at the Swap Meet, or of the same standard. Should there be a significant difference in condition, **the buyer is not obligated to purchase the item and may opt to cancel the transaction.**

- 7. Please ensure every piece of item is accompanied by a tag, including samples. **Use one tag per item.**
- 8. You may drop off your items with another parent to sell. However, please arrange with the parent to have unsold items taken at the end of the Swap Meet as well as the payment accrued from any sales. All parents are welcome to stay at the Swap Meet until your item gets sold.
- 9. All unsold items that are not picked up by the end of the Swap Meet will be disposed of without prior consent from the seller. You may request someone to pick up your unsold items.
- 10. All transactions will be only **cash or electronic transfers.** Cheques will not be accepted.
- 11. Transactions are strictly between the seller and the buyer. The PEC and any Parent Volunteers will not be held liable for any discrepancy or dispute arising from any failed transaction. We are simply acting as the facilitator during this event.
