NO income tax receipts can be issued if the information is incomplete or illegible.

C. THE WALK:

The day will begin at 8:45 as usual. The classes will depart in intervals following an assembly of all students in the gym. All the students will walk to and from Garden City Park and will return to school.

Dismissal is at 12:15pm for all grades, Kindergarten to Grade Seven.

D. WALKATHON PLEDGE RULES:

1. All pledges must be entered on the attached pledge sheet.
2. Complete ALL the information on the pledge sheet.
3. We encourage the whole family to participate.
4. The pledge sheet and money are due in school no later than **Tuesday, October 10th**.

Students are not permitted to obtain pledges from other students in the school.
