We are excited to continue our annual Christmas charity project in support of Luke 15 House. Over the past couple years, our staff has spent time preparing and sharing meals, doing activities, and sharing our faith with the men living there. The experience has been so uplifting and meaningful, that we continue to explore all the different ways we can support the residents of Luke 15 House.

Beginning this Monday, we are asking each child to bring in items that have been assigned to their class. Collection will take place all next week, with the **final day to send items being Monday**, **Dec. 8th**. The staff will package the care kits on Tuesday the 9th, and then the staff will deliver the packages to Luke 15 House on Wednesday the 10th. We will spread a little Christmas cheer, prepare and share a meal with the men, and do some fun activities.

Your child is asked to bring in the item(s) that is/are assigned to their class, as well as \$5 cash. The \$5 cash will be put towards the purchase of gift cards for the residents, in addition to the care kit items. Each of the items listed below has been sourced from **Dollarama** to cost approximately \$5, and then another \$5 cash will make it a total donation per child of \$10.

Please send in your child's item(s), according to your child's class, as well as \$5 per child by Dec. 8th:

Kindergarten: 2 standard bars of soap (90g each) and \$5

Grade 1: one adult toque (large) and \$5

Grade 2: comb set and 1 lip balm and \$5

Grade 3: one pair of **extra large** gloves **and** \$5

Grade 4: deodorant (85g) and \$5

Grade 5: shampoo (min. 750mL) and \$5

Grade 6: pack of men's razors and \$5

Grade 7: one adult toothbrush and toothpaste (150mL) and \$5
